Copy of current Health Care License or Certificate (if applicable) in: LVN, Psych Tech, Respiratory Therapist, RT Asst, CNA, EMT, MA, OT Aide, Pharmacy Tech, Phlebotomist, Dental Asst, Paramedic, Surgical Tech, Home Health Aide, Acute Care

Verification of Work or Volunteer experience - if applicable (100 hours minimum for volunteer hours) on letterhead of recent Health Care experience (must be within 3 years)

Verification of Life Experiences - must provide proof if applicable. Refer to the application for more information. (May check up to five areas):

Disabilities (Section 2626 of the unemployment insurance code

Low Family Income (Financial aide, fee waiver, summary page of income tax return, aid from the State)

1st Generation in College (EOPS/Upward Bound/letter from HS counselor, teacher/Clergy)

Need to work (letter from employer or pay stub w/explanation)

Disadvantaged Social or Educational Environment (letter required)

Difficult Personal/Family situations or circumstances (personal statement)

Refugee or Veteran Status (documentation of status required)

Other Language Spoken:

Transcripts that show third level of foreign language class completed

International Evaluation of education completed in their country

AP test scored of foreign language completed in their country

Letter or pay stub indicating bilingual pay

Letter from foreign language instructor that verifies proficiency

ATI/TEAS test - Test #5.0 with a minimum score of 62%. This test is required <u>after</u> acceptance into the program. If you have already taken the ATI/TEAS please provide results directly from ATI to Rio Hondo College electrionically. (1st time results accepted only)
