- For CSU admission, 30 units of general education courses must be completed with grades of "C" or better.
- Courses may be used to fulfill only one General Education area.
- Courses used to fulfill General Education may double count with courses used to fulfill a major requirement.
- Courses on this list are approved for the academic year 2024-2025 which is valid beginning Fall 2024 through Summer 2025.
