- I. Introduction
  - A. The Rio Hondo College Superintendent/President or designee shall authorize a department/division to facilitate:
    - 1. Cooperation with federal, state, and/or local health officers in measures necessary for the prevention and control of communicable diseases in students
    - 2. Compliance with any immunization/vaccination program required by federal, state, and/or local health department regulations
- II. Vaccine and Immunization Plan
  - A. Epidemics and pandemics have their own unique set of circumstances requiring a tailored response from the District to effectively respond to the health crisis. In the event the District requires students to be vaccinated, the District will develop a Vaccination and Immunization Plan. The Vaccination and Immunization Plan will contain the following and will be published on the College website:
    - 1. A section outlining the reasoning for the vaccination and immunization requirements
    - 2. Available exemptions under relevant law
    - 3. List of applicable rules, laws, and regulations
    - 4. Accommodation process information (i.e., Americans with Disabilities Act)
    - 5. Process and information to submit proof of vaccination
    - 6. Where to find up-to-date information on the epidemic or pandemic
    - 7. Vaccination mandate effective dates
